
We work with a diverse range of themes and projects in order to build up your skills and introduce you to a wide range of creative opportunities.







No exams – 100% Coursework

Our unit structure gives students the freedom to sample different areas of creative practice and to choose which areas interest them.


In the later stages of the course, students get to write, develop and exhibit their own personal art and design project in the theme and creative area of their choice.

4 GCSE passes (Grade C or above) to include Art or an Art related subject (e.g. Moving Image Arts / Design) and a portfolio of work or equivalent*. All applicants are interviewed and should present a portfolio of recent work which demonstrates creative ability and potential in the area of art, design and craft.

This can include evidence of drawing, painting, making, designing, digital artwork, sketchbooks, loose sheets, prep work, models and finished pieces (or photographs if they are too large to bring) created during your art and design studies and other related subject areas e.g. Design Technology /Moving Image.






